## The Great Apostasy

This is so simple, so straightforward and so conclusive it could not be possible for the leadership, theologians and translators to have missed the connection.

2 Thessalonians 2:3 Let no man deceive you by any means: for that day shall not come, except there come a falling away <646> first, and that man of sin be revealed, the son of perdition;

Acts 21:21 And they are informed of thee, that thou teachest all the Jews which are among the Gentiles to forsake <646> Moses, saying that they ought not to circumcise their children, neither to walk after the customs.

Strong's Number **<646>** is 'apostasy', as you can see in the chart below.

Therefore Paul's warning in 2 Thessalonians is that there will be a "Great Forsaking".

Forsaking of what? Jude explains,

**Jude 1:3-4** Beloved, when I gave all diligence to write unto you of the common salvation, it was needful for me to write unto you, and exhort you that ye should earnestly contend for <u>the faith which was once delivered unto the saints.</u> For there are certain men crept in unawares, who were before of old ordained to this condemnation, ungodly men<u>, turning the grace of our YHWH into lasciviousness</u>, and denying the only Sovereign Being, and our Master Yahushua HaMashiach.

Read Acts 20:26-31 and you will perceive that Paul is referring to the "apostasy". The truth is that the 'forgiveness of sins' and 'eternal life' are two different things. You cannot receive 'eternal life' without keeping the commandments(Matt 19:17, Rev 22:14). Satan has lied to and through the church. YHWH will destroy this earth and those in it that forsake (apostatize) the Eternal Covenant, Torah.

Isaiah 24:5 The earth also is defiled under the inhabitants thereof; because they have transgressed the laws, changed the ordinance, broken the everlasting covenant.
